The tournament will feature SEVEN (7) divisions of play: **MEN'S AAA, MEN'S A1, MEN'S A2, MEN'S B, BOYS 18-UNDER, BOYS 15-UNDER, BOYS 13-UNDER AND WOMEN'S OPEN.**

Players and teams of all abilities are welcome to participate in a division that's best suited for them. Each team is guaranteed to play in at least 3 games with teams that advance to the playoff round playing 4-5 games.

NOTE: This year's tournament will also act as a final tune-up for those teams preparing to play at the upcoming Chinese Nationals in Boston during the Memorial Day Weekend.

How To Sign Up

Deadline: On a first come first paid basis till divisions are filled or Friday, April 1, 2011 whichever comes first.

DIVISIONS OF PLAY:

Saturday, April 16, 2011

MEN'S AAA (limit 8-12 teams) - Our elite division, this is where the best teams from New York, New Jersey, Philadelphia, Washington, and the east coast compete for bragging rights. This is the division where many former/current high school/college standouts compete against the best. Bring it on. (Very competitive)

Sunday, April 17, 2011

MEN'S A1 (limit 6-9 teams) - This division is perfect for those teams that are on the rise or those teams that are more experienced and still got some game. (Somewhat Competitive)

BOYS 18-UNDER (6-9 teams) – It's the boys chance to shine as the best up and coming ballers get to showcase their skills. A special price for this division is \$275/team

Saturday, April 30, 2011

BOYS 15-UNDER (limit 6-8 teams) – This is where the hoop dreamers that have just begun to emerge as the future stars of Asian basketball. A special price for this division is \$275/team.

BOYS 13-UNDER (limit 6-8 teams) – At this age, it's where kids have fun and begin to show their passion for the game. A special price for this division is \$275/team.

Sunday, May 1, 2011 (revised)

WOMEN'S OPEN (limit 6-8 teams) – Another opportunity for the Women/Girls to hoop it up and prepare for the Chinese Nationals.

MEN'S A2 (limit 6-8 teams) - This division is perfect for those teams that are on the rise or those teams that are more experienced and still got some game. (Somewhat Competitive)

MEN'S B (limit 4-6 teams) - for those teams that play occasionally and are less competitive.

COST: \$300/TEAM. Checks for payment will only be accepted if received before April 1, 2011. Checks should be made payable to: New York Rockits Athletes In Action and sent to: New York Rockits Athletes In Action, 36 Market Street, #3, NYC, NY 10002.

FASTEST WAY: To guarantee or reserve a spot for your team before the divisions are filled, you can pay through paypal account or credit card on www.asianhoops.com. Your team is accepted to play after a confirmation email is sent to your team.

Note: No monies will be collected on the day of the tournament. The only way to reserve a spot for your team is to pay either by check, credit card or paypal. No spots will be held without payment.

AWARDS: (11) Individual trophies for 1st place and a Championship trophy. Team trophy for 2nd place.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Each team is guaranteed to play three games in the tournament with teams advancing into the playoff round playing possibly 4 or 5 total games.

REFEREES: Certified I.A.A.B.O. referees and referees in training will make the calls for all games so you don't have too.

WHO CAN PLAY: The 13th Annual Asian Basketball Classic is an invitational tournament and is open to all teams and players of Asian Oriental descent. Players must be at least 50% Oriental Asian to be eligible to play. Questions on ethnicity and eligibility should be brought to the attention of the organizer prior to submitting rosters to avoid any conflicts. The definition of a player of Oriental descent is as follows: at least one grandparent must be of 100% Oriental heritage. (Oriental nationalities are as follows: Chinese, Filipinos, Koreans, Vietnamese, Thai, Cambodian, Malaysian, Indonesian, and Japanese)

BURDEN OF PROOF: Organizers will request proof from all players that may be in question. Proper documentation will be required. Illegible copies will not be accepted. The burden of proof is on you to prove your ethnicity (*Playing in a tournament previously hosted by us does not mean you are eligible to play at this event*).
